Dear Colleague,

We are currently seeking applicants for our clinical post-residency Laryngeal Surgery Fellowship Program for 2018-2019. Next year will be the 20th anniversary of our post-residency program. The majority of our trainees have pursued academic positions, although aspiring to an academic career is not a prerequisite. Institutions where our graduates have taken positions include Johns Hopkins, Mayo Clinic, Harvard, Emory, Cleveland Clinic, University of Wisconsin, Case Western, Boston Children's Hospital, University of Miami, and McGill University. Our two most recent June graduates are now at New York University and University of Chicago.

The fellowship training covers all aspects of laryngeal surgery, voice disorders, and management of the professional voice. The fellows receive an especially comprehensive experience in the management of glottic cancer/dysplasia, RRP, vocal cord paralysis, stenosis, and voice problems in singers. There is extensive exposure to the latest office-based procedures as well as transoral and transcervical surgical techniques in the operating room. The fellows participate in clinical management of voice disorders and clinical research as a member of a multidisciplinary team (voice scientists and speech pathologists) that has access to state-of-the-art voice clinic and surgical engineering laboratory facilities.

If you have residents who are interested in pursuing a career in Laryngology after residency with a focus on innovative techniques in laryngeal surgery, please have them contact us (see below). They should be aware that we are interviewing now and do not participate in the matching program. We will be selecting from the candidates on a rolling basis. In recognition of the increasing financial pressures of most trainees, we have set the annual salary to \$110,000. If you have residents that would like to meet in person at the Academy meeting in San Diego we are pleased to try and do so.
